WHAT IMPACT **HAS THE ESSENTIALS** STORE MADE **ON OUR** COMMUNITY?

In the past year, Essentials has more than doubled the number of households that are being served per month, and the organization has significantly increased the number of donors, business connections, and organizational partners. There has been more work done this past year in creating awareness in the community than has ever been done before. Essentials has also reconnected to the Frontline congregation, which is evidenced through an increase in items donated as well as an increase in the number of volunteers serving within the organization.

The intangible impact on the Essentials community is even greater. Every week members share prayer requests and answered prayers. Addictions have been broken because of someone finally feeling a sense of belonging. Suicidal thoughts were broken when a member knew that they had a community to go to for prayer the next morning. One member donated needed baby items to another member who was in desperate need. A single mom, who felt so lost, got connected to community and found hope again. An Essentials member came to a Christmas service and gave her life to Christ. There are many more stories of impact and there will be many more to come. God has big plans for Essentials.
